Randy Pierce—founder and president of the charitable organization 2020 Vision Quest—is an entrepreneur, adventurer and philanthropist. A lifelong New Hampshire resident, he graduated from UNH in 1988 with a Bachelor’s degree in Electrical Engineering and began his first career as a computer hardware design engineer. Spare-time pursuits since college have included extensive experience in martial arts, hiking, bicycling, and running races.

Randy is also totally blind.

Always embodying the 2020 Vision Quest theme of “Achieve a Vision Beyond Your Sight,” he has continually forged ahead to experience an amazing variety of adventures and accomplishments—all part of the impactful story he's here to share. To list a few highlights, he’s won two National Marathon Championships, run in six consecutive Boston Marathons; has summited Mt. Kilimanjaro in Tanzania, trekked through the Andes in Peru, and climbed all 48 of the New Hampshire White Mountains’ 4,000-footers twice. He’s also competed in three Tough Mudder events, and in 2018 released his first book titled “*See You at the Summit.*”

Randy will share with us today/tonight some of the details of his journey and many lessons available to us all—both personally and professionally--about striving for our own versions of “Peak Potential.”
